**Love You Forever by Robert Munsch has sold over 15,000,000 copies.**

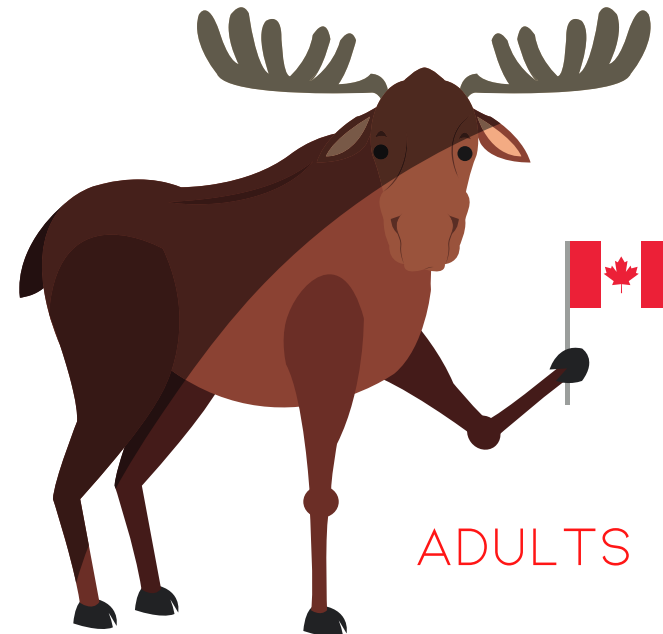
